Slay Transportation's Leadership Team strongly supports and encourages all employees and drivers to follow health and safety training programs provided by the company as a means of establishing prevention measures aimed at reducing employee or driver injuries or illnesses relating to the workplace.

Slay Transportation's health goal is to operate accident and incident free. It is the expectation of the Slay Leadership Team that all employees and drivers will fully support this policy and employ work practices that will demonstrate the effectiveness of our health and safety policies.

Slay Transportation will also comply with relevant regulations as issued by:

- The Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA)
- The Department of Transportation (DOT), and
- All other applicable federal, state, and local health regulations.

In addition, Slay Transportation is committed to comply with the Responsible Care® related requirements to which we voluntarily ascribe.

Slay Transportation employees and drivers are to conduct work activities in such a way as to protect and preserve the health and safety of all employees and drivers.

As an employee of Slay Transportation, you have the authority to step in and stop ongoing operations if you feel that a situation or behavior is unsafe or that conditions could potentially lead to an accident. There will be no sanctions, even in the event of incorrect use. "If it's not safe, don't do it."
